

Chapter 16

PLUMBING AND PLUMBERS*

Sec. 16-1. Plumbing Code.

- a) There is hereby adopted the current Code, as amended, by the State of South Dakota State Plumbing Commission. A copy of this publication is on file in the office of the Water Superintendent and is available and subject to public inspection at all times.
- b) It shall be unlawful for any person to fail to obey any of the provisions of the Code adopted by this Section.

Sec. 16-2. Plumbers license.

No person shall contract as a master or journeyman plumber in the City without a valid plumbers license issued by the state. In addition, such person shall file such bond as may be required by the Board of Commissioners.

Sec. 16-2.1. License fee.

A person desiring the license for a plumber shall pay an annual license fee of twenty dollars (\$20.00).

Editors note -Being not specifically amendatory of this Code, the provisions of Ord. No. 1016, adopted July 8, 1985, have been codified herein as a new 16-2.1 at the editors discretion.

Sec. 16-3. Enforcement.

- a) Under the observation of the Water Superintendent, it shall be the duty of the South Dakota State Plumbing Commission (Commission) to enforce the plumbing provisions as set forth in the statutes and administrative rules of the State of South Dakota and the provisions of this article.
- b) All plumbing, building sewer, drain-waste-vent, irrigation, and internal water supply system work, in the process of construction, installation, alteration or repair, shall be under the supervision of the Commission. Inspectors employed by the Commission shall carry out inspections of above referenced work within the City of Madison. Commission inspections may be performed at random or as a requirement at the discretion of the Commission and its inspectors. Commission inspections may also be performed upon request made 48 hours in advance by the owner, contractor, installer, or plumber.

- c) The Commission is empowered to stop such work if the same is violation of the state plumbing code. All violations of the state plumbing code shall be cited and administered in accordance with administrative rules of the state of South Dakota pertaining to plumbing.
- d) The Commission shall have the right during reasonable hours to enter any building, structure, or premise in the discharge of official duties pertaining to the construction, installation, alteration or repair of plumbing, building sewer, drainwaste- vent, irrigation, and internal water supply systems.
