

**ORDINANCE NO. 1542**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 7 - ELECTRICITY AND ELECTRICIANS -  
ARTICLE 3 – MUNICIPAL LIGHT DEPARTMENT BY ADDING A SECTION  
RELATING TO SECURITY LIGHTS WITHIN MADISON.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MADISON, SOUTH  
DAKOTA:

That a section of the Revised Ordinances of the City of Madison also known as the Code of  
Ordinances be added to read as follows:

**Sec. 7-55. Security lights.**

- A. Security lights may be installed at primarily residential locations as approved by the  
Electrical Superintendent upon request by a customer.
- B. Security lights will be put on existing line poles where practical to provide supplemental  
illumination to customer owned lights. If existing line poles are removed, the customer  
will have to provide alternate lighting.
- C. Rates for security lighting shall include:
  - 1. the City's recovery cost for the light assembly
  - 2. repair and maintenance of the light
  - 3. the cost for electricity to be provided to the light
- D. Any additional costs for installation of security lights shall be billed to the customer.
- E. If the customer requires a pole to be set, the pole shall be located on the customer's  
property and the customer will be billed for the pole which shall become the customer's  
property. The light will remain the property of and be maintained by the City.
- F. No more than (4) four security lights will be installed in any storage or parking lot.
- G. No security lights will be installed in any hard surfaced storage or parking lot.
- H. Restoration of ground surface, regardless of type, shall be the responsibility of the  
customer.
