

**ORDINANCE NO. 1548**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 11 – MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC –  
ARTICLE 3 – OPERATION – DIVISION 3 – SPEED BY AMENDING A SECTION  
RELATED TO SPEED LIMIT IN SCHOOL ZONES**

WHEREAS, the City of Madison hereby creates “school zones” for the purpose of regulating speed and traffic; and

WHEREAS, the City of Madison believes it is necessary to establish defined school zones for the public welfare and safety of its citizens;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MADISON, SOUTH DAKOTA:

That Section 11-123 of the Revised Ordinances of the City of Madison, also known as the Code of Ordinances, be amended to read as follows:

**Sec. 11-123. School zones.**

(a) Creation of school zones

1. 9th Street NE from Summit Avenue to Maplewood Avenue
2. 11th Street NE from Summit Avenue to Maplewood Avenue
3. 9th Street NW from Liberty Avenue to West Avenue
4. 3rd Street NW from Van Eps Avenue to Blanche Avenue
5. Van Eps Avenue from 3rd Street NW to 4th Street NW

(b) Signage and speed

1. Between the posted signs in each school zone between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. the speed limit shall be set at 15 miles per hour and 20 miles per hour at all other times.
2. The City of Madison may provide, erect and maintain school zone signs.

(c) Penalty

1. Section 1-8 of the Revised Ordinances of the City of Madison shall apply.
