

**ORDINANCE NO. 1571**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 18 – STREETS AND SIDEWALKS – ARTICLE V  
– SNOW REMOVAL BY AMENDING SECTION 18-97 REGARDING REMOVAL OF  
VEHICLES**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MADISON, SOUTH  
DAKOTA:

That Section 18-97 of the Revised Ordinances of the City of Madison, also known as the Code of  
Ordinances, be amended to read as follows:

**Sec. 18-97. Removal of vehicles.**


Vehicles parked on an emergency snow route, the commercial core area, designated city owned  
parking lots or on any street, avenue or alley after an emergency snow alert is declared are subject to  
an immediate parking ticket with a twenty-five dollar (\$25.00) fine and a twenty-four (24) hour tow  
warning. If the vehicle has not been moved in twenty-four (24) hours, it will be subject to towing at  
the owner's expense.
