

RESOLUTION NO. 2014-24

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR A SD DOT TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM (TAP) GRANT

WHEREAS, the City of Madison has identified the desire to construct a multi-use path in order to improve the quality of life for all residents of the city; and

WHEREAS, the City of Madison now requests financial assistance to complete the proposed project; and

WHEREAS, the project is eligible for SD Department of Transportation for Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) funding to assist with the costs of the project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Madison will have exceeded the minimum required local match of 18.05 percent when including staff labor contributed toward the project and other direct costs already paid toward the project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MADISON, SOUTH DAKOTA:


1. That the City of Madison supports the project and the submittal of a TAP application.
2. That, if funded in the amount not less than \$72,500 in TAP funds, the City of Madison will pay the required local match for eligible project costs in cash.
3. That the City of Madison agrees to be responsible for all future operations and maintenance costs of the project, including but not limited to, snow removal, throughout its useful life.
4. That Mayor Roy Lindsay, Jr., is hereby authorized to execute and file the application to the SD Department of Transportation for TAP funding.
