



Why Recycle?

Twice a year Lake County holds an **Electronic Drop Off Event** at the Madison Recycling Center.

Each **May** the City of Madison partakes in a City Wide Clean Up.

Every **Wednesday** the City of Madison collects recyclables from garbage customers. The Madison Recycling Center is open Tuesday through Saturday from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. for drop off of recyclable materials from any individual or business.

The **Madison Yard Waste Site** is located off of Hwy 34 on 456th Ave (just north of the Waste Water Treatment Plant) and is open year round for grass clippings, garden waste, Christmas trees, pumpkins, untreated lumber, and branches (no bags allowed and no stumps allowed).

Per City Ordinance Chapter 9 Section 13, *'Any and all person(s), firm(s), corporation(s), institution(s), or facility(ies) are required to employ the services of a licensed garbage hauler to pick up and dispose of garbage, rubbish, or waste materials.'*

Solid Waste Guidelines

Solid Waste Guidelines

GARBAGE ROUTES

Mondays Route: east of Egan Ave. and north of NE 2nd St.

Tuesdays Route: east of Egan Ave. and south of NE 2nd St.

Wednesdays: recycling pickup for current garbage customers.

Thursdays Route: west of Egan Ave. and north of NW 2nd St.

Fridays Route: west of Egan Ave. and south of NW 2nd St.



GARBAGE GUIDELINES

- All garbage must be bagged.
- All garbage must fit inside your cart with lid closed.
- All carts must be placed within 3 feet of the curb or alley. (not in street)
- Set out your garbage by 7:00 a.m. on your scheduled collection day. **There are no set times for collection.**
- If your garbage is set out late, it will not be collected until the following week.
- Do not place bricks, car parts, concrete or other construction materials in your garbage.
- Do not place recyclables, yard waste, paint, batteries, electronic devices, or hazardous materials/solvents/waste oil in your garbage.


MANDATORY RECYCLING PROGRAM

RECYCLING ROUTES:

All Recycling is picked up curbside

- **East of Egan Ave.**—Collection is the 1st and 3rd Wednesday of each month.
- **West of Egan Ave.**—Collection is the 2nd and 4th Wednesday of each month.

There is no pick up on the 5th Wednesday of each month.



* Rinse all containers * Remove all lids * Do not worry about removing labels * Separate items as shown * Place all recyclables (except cardboard) in clear or white plastic bags * All recyclables must be clean & dry * Flatten cardboard boxes * All items must be placed curbside by 7:00 a.m. on collection days, **there are no set times for collection.**
