Notice is hereby given that City of Madison will receive sealed bids for construction of Madison Water System Improvements – Phase 1A. Project scope will include the following:

- Furnish and Install approximately 1,100 LF of 8” diameter and 7,100 LF of 6” diameter water main and associated service lines;
- Furnish and Install approximately 3,650 LF of 8” diameter gravity sewer with associated service lines;
- Furnish and Install approximately 920 LF of RCP storm sewer;
- Furnish and Install sanitary sewer and water tracer wire systems;
- Furnish and Install junction boxes, manholes, valves and appurtenances;
- Approximately 29,320 SY of full depth roadway reclamation;
- Furnish and Install approximately 21,400 SY of geotextile fabric for subgrade stabilization;
- Furnish and Install approximately 26,000 Tons of base course;
- Furnish and Install approximately 29,000 SY of asphalt concrete;
- Furnish and Install approximately 2,200 SY of PCC approach pavement;
- Furnish and Install approximately 14,500 LF of concrete curb & gutter;
- Furnish and install approximately 17,500 SF of concrete sidewalk;
- Surface restoration and all other miscellaneous work required not herein mentioned, but inferred from the construction Contract Documents.

The Bids must be prepared on bid forms supplied in the Bidding Documents and filed with City of Madison, 116 West Center Street, Madison, SD 57042 not later than 2:00pm, Local Time, April 9, 2020, at which time and place all Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud in the presence of the Bidders and their representatives. No bids will be received after the specified hour and date, and Bids which are not prepared and filed in accordance with “Instructions to Bidders” may be rejected.

Each Bid must be submitted in a sealed envelope. Each sealed envelope containing a Bid must be plainly marked on the outside as Bid for Madison Water System Improvements – Phase 1A. The envelope should also bear on the outside the name and address of the Bidder. If forwarded by mail or other delivery system, the sealed envelope containing the Bid must be sealed in another envelope, with the notation “Bid Enclosed” on the face thereof, and addressed to City of Madison, 116 West Center Street, Madison, SD 57042.

A pre-bid meeting will not be held.

Upon request, in accordance with South Dakota Codified Law 5-18B-1, one copy of electronic or paper Plans and Specifications shall be furnished, without charge, to each Prime Contractor resident in South Dakota who intends, in good faith, to submit a bid to the Owner. Additionally, if a paper copy is provided under the conditions of SDCL 5-18B-1, in consideration of the documents being provided at no charge, unsuccessful bidders agree to return the documents to the office of Banner Associates, at the address listed above, within thirty (30) days after the bid opening.

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The Bidder to whom the contract is awarded will be required to furnish a construction performance bond and a construction payment bond to the Owner in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the contract award for each bond, in conformance with the requirements of the Contract Documents. The construction performance bond and construction payment bond shall remain in full force until the completion of the Contract as specified in the General Conditions.

All bids must be accompanied by a Bid security. Bid security will take the form of a bid bond in an amount of ten percent (10%) of the Bidder's maximum Bid price or a cashier's or certified check made payable to Owner in an amount of five percent (5%) of the Bidder's maximum Bid price. The Bid security will be retained by the Owner as liquidated damages if the successful bidder refuses or fails to enter into an Agreement within fifteen (15) days after Notice of Award or fails at time of executing the contract to furnish a construction performance bond and construction payment bond guaranteeing the faithful performance of the work.

Bids may not be withdrawn after the time fixed for opening them. The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all bids, and to waive any irregularities therein.

Section 746 of Title VII of the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2017 (Division A - Agriculture, Rural Development, Food and Drug Administration, and Related Agencies Appropriations Act, 2017) and subsequent statutes mandating domestic preference applies an American Iron and Steel requirement to this project. All listed iron and steel products used in this project must be produced in the United States. The term "iron and steel products" means the following products made primarily of iron or steel: lined or unlined pipes and fittings, manhole covers and other municipal castings, hydrants, tanks, flanges, pipe clamps and restraints, valves, structural steel, reinforced precast concrete, and construction materials.
