Scholarships Can Make a Difference

Did you know that for less than one dollar a month you can help make a difference in a young person's life? By joining others in our community, you can help fund a scholarship to enable deserving young people to pursue their dreams through a college education.

Customers of the City of Madison Utilities have the opportunity to help fund scholarships for Madison High School students by allowing their city utility bills to be rounded up to the nearest whole dollar. The additional amount is given to the Madison Central School Educational Foundation to build a scholarship fund. No customer will ever pay more than \$11.88 per **year**.

The initial goal was to provide a scholarship to every graduating Madison High School senior, but given the current numbers, that goal was improbable; therefore, the program was modified in 2008 to provide a scholarship to each MHS graduate who continues their education at Dakota State University.
