1. What purpose will the requested funds fulfill?

The Domestic Violence Network is a domestic violence and sexual assault emergency crisis center that serves victims in the Madison area. Recently, the Domestic Violence Network has been working towards accessing a new and larger facility. This funding will help the Domestic Violence Network access and maintain this larger facility.

2. When will the funds be used?

The funds will be used to purchase security fencing around the property. Any remaining funds will be used to pay for the purchase of these new buildings.

3. How will the activity/project benefit the City of Madison? What target population will be served by this funding? Approximately how many people will benefit from this activity/project? *These funds must be used to benefit residents of the City of Madison.*

The Domestic Violence Network serves domestic violence and sexual assault victims. In a typical year, DVN serves approximately 130 individuals per year. 80% of these individuals are residents of Madison and 90% reside in Lake County. DVN provides emergency shelter, food, clothing, personal advocacy, courtroom advocacy and a 24 hour a day 7 day a week crisis line to individuals fleeing domestic violence.

4. How, specifically, does your organization intend to use the funds requested? Do you have other funding sources to address this need? If this is a new program/initiative, how will you assure future funding sources?

The funding will be used to purchase security fencing around the property to enable DVN clients that are staying at the shelter to be able to go outside with their children and play. With this funding, clients will feel more secure and safe. The DVN utilizes fundraising activities such as the DVN annual "Tour of Tables" and "Laughs and Linguini" and grant writing activities such as United Way, Department of Public Safety, and SD housing to continue to support our existing services and programs.

5. What are your plans for evaluation? What will you measure in order to determine success of the program or initiative being funded?

The Domestic Violence Network is required to report quarterly to the Department of Public Safety and to SD housing, the services DVN provides, the number and characteristics of individuals DVN serves and the outcomes of these services. This information is supportive or providing information on the strengths of services and how services can be improved.
