

ORDINANCE NO. 1356

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MADISON, SOUTH DAKOTA, AMENDING
THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY BY ADDING A SECTION
ELIMINATING ELECTRONIC GOODS FROM THE WASTE STREAM

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SIOUX FALLS, SD:

That Section 9 of the Revised Ordinances of Madison, SD, is hereby amended by adding the following definitions 9-1 (17), 9-1 (18) and Section 9-21.

9-1 (18)

“Large electronics” means desktop and laptop personal computers, monitors, mainframe computers, battery backup uninterruptible power supplies, printers, scanners, copy machines, fax machines, televisions, video cassette recorders, laser disc players, digital video disc players and stereo receivers.

9-1 (19)

“Hand-held electronics” means cell phones, pagers, personal digital assistants, handheld video games, calculators, small MP3 players, small compact disc players, small cassette players, small radios, small walkie-talkies and digital and electronic cameras.

9-21 Electronics

It shall be unlawful to combine, mix or dispose of any large electronics and hand-held electronics within garbage or rubbish either through the solid waste collection system or at the restricted use site.
