



### **Calling for Inspections**

Below is a breakdown of when to call for each respective inspection. Please do not call for inspection prior to the project being ready. Forgetting to call for inspection may result in removal of work or materials necessary to expose framing or rebar.

- 1) Footing Inspection: To be made after excavation for footings are complete and any required reinforcing steel is in place but before any concrete has been poured.
- 2) Foundation Wall Inspection: To be made after wall forms and required reinforcing is in place but before any concrete has been poured.
- 3) Framing Inspections: To be made after all framing, fire blocking and bracing are in place and all pipes, chimneys and vents are complete. Electrical and plumbing shall be already approved prior to framing inspection. The framing inspection is to be made prior to any insulating or wall coverage.
- 4) Sheetrock Inspection: To be made after all gypsum board is in place, but before any plastering is applied or gypsum board joints and fasteners are taped and finished.
- 5) Final Inspection: To be made after finish grading and the building is completed and ready for occupancy.
- 6) Other Special Inspections: As noted on the building permit, under special cases.
