MADISON'S MANDATORY RECYCLING COLLECTION PROGRAM

All Recyclables Must be Separated For Collection As Follows

Clear or white plastic bags must be used for recycling collection. All bags must be placed curbside for collection by 7:00 am on collection day.

Corrugated cardboard does not need to be bagged but must be clean and dry.

**Recycling collection days for city garbage customers is as follows:
East of Egan Ave. collection is the 1st and 3rd Wednesday of each month
West of Egan Ave. collection is the 2nd and 4th Wednesday of each month
There is no collection on the 5th Wednesday.**
